STUDENT ACTIVITY

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

In this activity, you will prepare a travelogue sharing a school travel experience with your classmates. Presentation techniques may vary from showing a videotape, presenting a slide show, or creating your own artwork. The presentation to the class is visual storytelling. It should be appealing and interesting.

PROCEDURE

1. Identify a humorous or even dramatic event that happened one day on your way to or from school. You are sharing a story from a trip that you took; the objective is to reveal the details of what made a trip to school interesting, frightening, fun, unique, or memorable, and worth sharing.



- 2. It's important to provide context for your story. Some items to consider in preparing your presentation are:
 - What do you do to prepare for your trip to and from school? (On the day that you are talking about, did you do anything different?)
 - How do you get there? (What is your normal mode of transportation? Did it vary on this specific day?)
 - Do you travel alone to school? ...with others? (How did this affect the event that happened?)
 - Does weather impact how you get to school? ...how long it takes you to get to school? (Did weather play a part in this event?)
- 3. Choose a method of presentation from the list provided by your teacher.
- 4. Make your presentation visually appealing. Use visual aids that can be seen by the entire class.
